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## London context

#### 21% London households are social renters

- 16% rest of England
- Higher proportion of local authority rental

#### Stock profile is different

- Over half of all London homes are flats/apartments/maisonettes
  - Three out of four social rent homes

More older homes, but they are in better condition, except when they're really not



## Key statistics

47% of cases come from London residents

Three times the expected ratio

54 of the 101 fire safety complaints

12 of the 31 structural safety complaints

12 of the 17 district heating complaints

56% of all shared/leasehold complaints

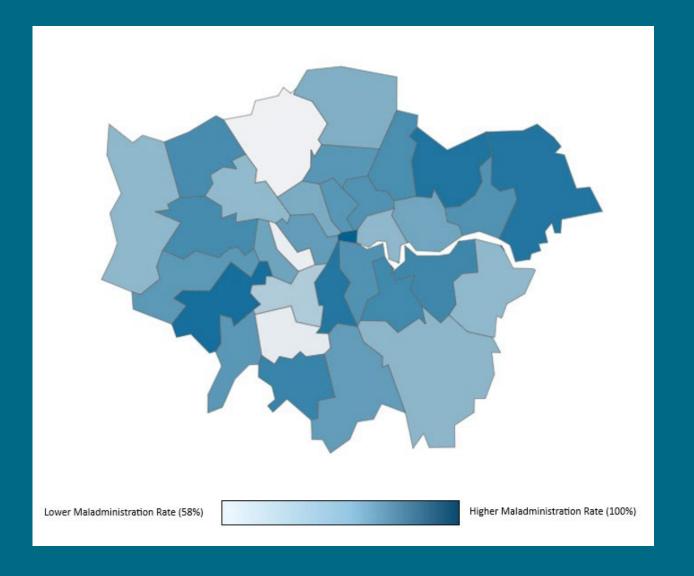
Over two thirds of all complaint handling failure orders

• 78%

Highest mal rate for health & safety

• 74%

Highest mal rate for ASB

• 73%
